2. Qualifying degree (Biological Sciences in Public Health) a. Master's/MPhil in life sciences that includes basic biochemistry and molecular biology training (Microbiology, Biotechnology, Biochemistry, Medical Biochemistry, Genetics, Biology, Health Sciences)
3. Qualifying degree (Human Nutrition, Public Health Nutrition) a. Masters/MPhil in Foods and Nutrition/Public Health/Epidemiology
