Guidelines for Submission

Participation Eligibility

• Only students of SJNAHS (SJMC, SJRI, College of Nursing, St Johns Allied Health) are eligible to participate in this competition. Participants can submit in pairs or groups, but all members must be identified. Only one entry will be accepted per participant/group and only one award will be given per entry, whether single participant or group. Certificates of Participation will be awarded to all participants.

Entry Format

- All entries shall be on the Theme of World Bioethics Day 2021
- All entries video, photo/digital art or audio should be submitted in digital format only (send a link if the file is large]
- Video films (less than 5 mins) may be shot in MPEG4 or AVI format. The
 recommended ratios are: 16:9 / 16:9 Full Height Anamorphic –in DV / HDV;
 Photograph/digital image (jpeg/jpg format not less than 300 dp); Audio file (less
 than 5 mins) MP3 format, WMA, DSD, MPEG4.
- All submitted audio/video work or photos/digital art should be the original work of the participant and entries should NOT have been presented at any other competition previously or concurrently or made available in any public domain (including electronic and non-electronic media).

Submission Process

- All entries should be sent to **humanities_events@sjri.res.in** by the **22nd Oct 2021**. Late entries shall not be entertained.
- Entries should carry the Name of the participant, Institute/College, year of study, date of the submission, phone number and email.
- Results will be declared before 28th Oct 2021.

Judging Criteria

- Audio/video/photo/digital art entries will be assessed for: Creativity and originality, Composition (Technical excellence and quality), Artistic merit ("Wow" factor) and Content (Relevance).
- The decision of the organizers shall be final and binding. No request to change the entry shall be entertained. Organizers will not be responsible for any claims challenging the authorship, or infringement on the privacy of any person clearly recognizable in the submitted entry. Participants agree to comply with and be bound by the decisions of the judges on all matters associated with the competition.
